- Red lights Danger. Stop immediately and refer to owner's manual.
- Amber lights System malfunction.
  Proceed with caution. Have vehicle checked by a technician immediately.
- Green lights Normal operation or function engaged.
  All lights appear for a system check when starting up.



- · Check windscreen washer levels regularly.
- Use washer fluid when re-filling reservoir
- · Replace wipers if they smear, streak, chatter or squeak.
  - Check for splits to rubber.
  - Replace just rubber or entire blade.

Keep headlights clean to improve visibility and reduce glare.



- · Remove unnecessary weight from the boot.
  - · Ensure car's tyres are correctly inflated.
- · Close windows and sunroof where possible.
- Choose routes where you can maintain a constant speed rather than stop start in traffic.
- · Remove roof bars and bike holders if not needed.

Drive smoothly - plan steady braking and accelerating.



- Always carry important documents with you (Registration document, insurance, passport).
- · Carry a warning triangle, reflective jackets, first aid kit.
  - · Keep replacement headlamp bulbs in your boot.
- . Drive on the left in the UK, Channel Islands, Ireland, Malta.
